Culture Wars

Culture: the ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular people or society.

A story of our times.

There is a fish living in one of our rivers, drawing its nutrients and oxygen from the water, its natural environment. It knows nothing else. What it does not know is that the river is becoming increasingly polluted and de-oxygenated from farming run-off and sewage discharges all of which are slowly killing it.

Culture can be a like that, hidden, insidious, negative and highly toxic whilst being claimed as the way we do things as if that's OK.

It's often hidden as we are blinded to it by familiarity. We know nothing else.

It is insidious. It is all pervasive getting in everywhere, in every area of our nation's life and relationships and especially but not exclusively in the political arena.

It is generally negative as it's as much about what it is against, generally other cultures and those who disagree with us, than what it is for.

Its hallmarks include Pride running into hubris, exclusive patriotism, partisanship and destructive nationalism amongst other unsavoury manifestations.

It is therefore highly toxic. It kills all of the qualities that we prize and that enrich life: love, joy, compassion, mercy, kindness, self-giving, humility and in fact the whole fruit of the Holy Spirit set out in Galatians 5:22-23.

No culture is exempt, especially our own.

Although we are called to be a counter-culture even church life can bear some of the toxicity. We often resort to doing things the world's way to gain approval, deflect potential criticism or get our own way. One particularly pernicious feature is a political mindset that sees difference as a threat that needs to be put down using worldly political means. It makes enemies of brothers and sisters in defiance of every teaching of Jesus and Biblical writers. Rather than embracing difference and diversity we seek to impose uniformity as if the only way to unity is if everyone sees things our way.

There are some positive characteristics in every culture, including our own, as we are all made in God's image however marred by sin. We do need however to submit ourselves to a rigorous examination by the Holy Spirit to have our eyes opened to the negative and toxic elements of our particular culture or sub-culture so that it can be redeemed by the Grace of God. This is the call on the Ekklesia of Jesus to show the world what heavenly culture and government looks like. Let's go for it.
